

## Quick Guide to accessing MBA Learning Center

Under your state's enhanced membership, your school is eligible for **one free teacher license** to access all material. This will allow the lead teacher or her designee to access any content of interest. Plus, for *this school year only*, additional complimentary accounts are available to a limited number of teachers per school.
